Russ Cunningham, Principal Planner with the City, will update the Committee on the status of several major Oceanside programs, including:

1	BikeShare Programs: -Coastal cities' joint BikeShare/ScooterShare programs -SANDAG's guidelines development -Oceanside's ordinance	3/15/21 - SANDAG has a scheduled BikeShare meeting the week of 3/15 to update on progress in Encinitas. Trek is the contractor now for Encinitas. Modified dock system with e-bikes only, mini docks throughout the city. Carlsbad will probably not agree to a BikeShare program due to pressure from bike rental companies.
2	Bike Storage Facility grant implementation.	4/19/21 - Project is complete. Ribbon cutting is being considered.
3	Loma Alta Creek bridge preliminary design and environmental.	3/15/21 - Should be completed in June. Dokken Engineering.
4	Mainstreet Downtown Shuttle Demonstration Project	3/15/21 - Now not felt likely to happen this summer. Howard to check.

5	Oceanside's Climate Action Plan (CAP) and its Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Ordinance and Plans	3/15/21 - Updates to CAP might be able to add more active transportation content. Pete pointed out the possible link of active transportation as a TDM benefit.
6	Onward Oceanside Corridor Plan (Part of General Plan Update)	Chen Ryan is the subconsultant on the mobility plan. Working on existing conditions.
7	LCI Classes (Cycling in Traffic)	3/15/21 - First in-person class conducted this past month.
8	Coast Highway Road Diet and Incentive Zone	To be updated at 5/17 meeting
9	Kelly Street Bike Bridge	
10	SANDAG's 5 Big Moves and their 2021 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP)	
11	SLR River trail ownership and improvement issues	3/15/21 - Dir of Public Works said property not likely to be transferred to the City for a long time. Slurry seal is ok but more permanent fixes may be problematic due to ownership issues. City is potentially liable for suits in event of serious accident.
12	El Corazon Park Trail System	
13	Annual Capital Improvement Program Projects	4/19/21 - As of this date, Bike and Ped budget remains funded at \$170K, to cover Coordinator and other projects/matches.
14	Coastal Rail Trail Segment between Morse and Eaton	3/15/21 - Grant submitted for study to improve segment, awaiting outcome
15	Loma Alta Creek bridge and connections final design & construction	4/19/21 - Caltrans again failed to fund grant application in last grant cycle, but CTC now appears ready to fund it as part of an Active Transportation Augmentation Program.
16	Inland Rail Trail	3/15/21 - Grant request for project study report submitted 2/12/21, awaiting outcome
